Event Description

The International Congress will gather professors from different disciplines, universities and Colombian regions who will present their research about the definitive solutions to the internal displacement and the Peace Agreement implementation from the perspective of justice and restoration.

Following the National Issues Forum methodology, there will be four workshops in which the public will be invited to participate and deliberate on specific proposals related to each workshop topic.

There will be eight international lectures by professors from Brazil, Italy and Spain.
